Established in 2018, Let's Do More CIC, is a socially inspired organisation, which uses sport as a means to engage, empower and raise the aspirations of young people living in some of the most deprived communities in Leeds. Since 2019, basketball has become our flagship sport and the LDM Basketball programme engages over 200 young people each week in basketball activity across multiple communities in Leeds.

The LDM Basketball programme is designed to provide basketball opportunities to players from all backgrounds and experiences, providing a pathway to the elite level of the game for those who aspire to pursue this. We run a multitude of school and community sessions across Leeds, which aim to introduce young people to basketball, with a view to developing their skills and confidence to join our various local and national league junior basketball teams.

## Role & Responsibilities

Our junior basketball programme based in Leeds, West Yorkshire is expanding and we require dedicated coaches to lead / support our growing number of college, school and community sessions across the city. Coaches will be expected to plan and develop sessions catering to a wide range of



abilities and experience levels, ensuring they are aware and up to date with current safeguarding protocols in line with our child protection policy. The main duties will be:

- The designing and delivery of basketball sessions suitable for community and school setting
- Maintaining high ethical standards in coaching/instructing, ensure they keep up-to-date with their knowledge, skills and qualifications and prepare all sessions in advance.
- Undertaking training appropriate to the role e.g child protection training
- Attending club meetings where appropriate and report on progress
